PRIVACY NOTICE

(In line with Data Protection and GDPR – General data Protection Regulation changes / updates – May 25th 2018)

We, (Malvern Hills District Brass band aka Malvern Brass Band), collect and process member's information as part of our public functions under both the Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulation.
